The Northern Neighbours Nurse Practitioner-Led Clinic (NNNPLC) provides primary health care services to the residents of White River and Netmizaaggamig Nishnaabeg. These services include: illness and injury treatment; physical exams; primary health care across the lifespan; prenatal care; immunizations; chronic disease care; counseling; diabetes education; and foot care.

Our Clinic is governed by a Board of Directors with a varied skill set. Our Board consists of Nurse Practitioners and Community members who are dedicated to professional merit, empathy, and inclusive care. We are currently recruiting additional Directors who share our commitment to fostering cultural safety.

Our Directors gain personal and professional board and committee experience through governance resources and networking with regional partners. You will join a supportive team that values a collaborative spirit and the philosophy of "Infinite Diversity in Infinite Combinations." We meet one evening every month and have an annual strategic planning day (next scheduled for June 10, 2026). There are additional opportunities to be involved with committees as desired.

- Experience in human resources management and government relations;
- Experience in strategic planning, risk management, and performance quality;
- Legal background or communications expertise are considered strong assets; and
- Willingness to devote the time and effort required to become an effective Board Director, including attendance at meetings and organizational events.
